The nominee can be any personnel (custodian, coach, teacher, secretary, counselor, superintendent, etc.) but they must have served our students for at least 5 years. The nominee must have received multiple nominations to be considered by the selection committee.

RAA Distinguished Educator Award Guidelines

Nominee will be considered based on the following criteria:

- Letter(s) received in nomination of the nominee
- Extra duties/responsibilities of the nominee (coaching, advisor, etc.)
- Personal awards/honors of the nominee (teacher of year, national recognized teacher, etc.)
- Contributions to the district by the nominee (honors helped district earn, above and beyond contributions to district, etc.)
- Years of service in the district by the nominee

Nominators shall submit on behalf of a Nominee:

- Application (including nominator and nominee information)
- Letter(s) and supporting evidence on why the nominee is deserving of the Distinguished Educator Award.
- Nominations stay permanently on file—although further letters by staff and students will further strengthen a nominee's chances of receiving the honor

Deadline:

- Nominations are due by June 1st of that year to be taken under consideration by the selection committee for recognition the following fall.

Selection Committee:

- The Selection Committee will be made up of the Chair of the Selection Committee, executive members of RAA (President, Treasurer, Secretary), as well as at least two current or former faculty/staff members of Revere Local School District (if two aren't already included via the Chair position and RAA executive members).

Procedure:

- After receiving a nomination, the Chair of the Selection Committee (Mr. Eric Moats) will contact the nominee to see if the person is willing to be considered for the award. At that time, the nominee will be asked to submit a resume outlining their years of service and any special contributions. The Chair of the Selection Committee may also contact the school district for supporting evidence (important if there is no available contact information for the nominee or the nominee is being considered in absentia).
- The committee will meet in June or July to meet to discuss the nominees. After a presentation of each nominee and an open discussion, a vote is held for each nominee. A majority vote by the committee for each is sufficient for receiving the award. No one is required to receive the award—if a majority vote is not met, no recipients that year. No more than two recipients in any given year, if more than two nominees receive a majority vote then the committee will do a numbered vote with all those receiving more than a majority vote (1st—12 points, 2nd—10 points, 3rd—8 points, 4th—6 points, 5th—4 points, 6th—2 points). Top two highest point totals receives award that year.
