Mission Statement:

Revere maximizes the collective resources of our community to inspire and prepare all students academically, emotionally, physically and socially to achieve their individual potential.

Community:

The Revere Local School District is located midway between Akron and Cleveland serving the communities of Bath and Richfield, Ohio. The district is rural and suburban with a few farms and diversified small businesses; the majority of the community is private residences. The income level is above average with professional, executive, and skilled occupations predominant.

School:

Revere High School continues to be recognized at a high level by the Ohio Department of Education. US News & World Report Magazine includes Revere among the top high schools in the United States. The enrollment for the 2018-19 school year is 8853 with a senior class of 225 students.

Faculty:

Revere High School has 56 full-time teachers, three administrators and three school counselors. Seventy-six percent of the teaching faculty hold advanced degrees including three National Board of Certified Teachers.

Curriculum:

Twenty-four (24) units required for graduation: 4 units of English, 3 units of Science, 4 units of Social Studies, 4 units of Math, 1 unit of Health and Physical Education, .5 unit of Computer Applications, .5 unit of Personal Finance, and 7 units of Electives.

Weighted Grades:

Revere High School uses a weighted 4.0 grading system. A factor of .5 is added to grades in Honors classes of C and above. A factor of 1.0 is added to grades in Advanced Placement and College Credit Plus courses of C and above.

Revere High School does not rank students. The class will be recognized at Commencement as Summa Cum Laude (4.0+ GPA); Magna Cum Laude (3.75-3.99 GPA); Cum Laude (3.50-3.74 GPA).
