Fort Laurens (near Canton) was the only American fort built in Ohio during the Revolutionary War. Find out about the building of this frontier outpost and its siege in 1768, where Colonel John Gibson defended the fort against British Captain Henry Bird and his Indian allies under prominent Lenape (Delaware) leader Konieschquanoheel--- also known by the English name "Captain Pipe"---and renegade Simon Girty.
