To ensure the safety of our athletes, coaches, and families, we will be following the same requirements and recommendations set forth by the OHSAA for middle school and high school wrestling. Please visit [here](#) for the complete set of requirements and recommendations.

WRESTLER/PARENT GUIDELINES AND POLICIES

1. Upon arrival each wrestler will check in with a coach/volunteer to conduct a symptom check and complete the Covid-19 Athlete Monitoring Form
 - * Any wrestler that answers "yes" to any of these questions, or has a fever above 100.4 degrees will be sent home immediately.
2. Upon completion of the check-in procedure, parents cannot remain for the duration of practice and must exit the building immediately
 - *This is a policy adopted by the Revere Local School District for all sports
3. All wrestlers must wear a facial covering upon entering and exiting the facility.
4. During non-wrestling times, wrestlers must practice social distancing, maintaining a minimum of six feet between them and other individuals
5. Wrestlers will bring their own water
 - *There will be no sharing of water, and water fountains will not be used.
6. Hand sanitizer will be made available before, during, and after practice
7. Wrestlers may not congregate together at the conclusion of practices
8. Parents should arrive for pick up no more than five minutes before the end of practice, and may wait in the hallway for their wrestler(s). During this time, parents must observe proper social distancing and wear facial coverings. Parents are not permitted to enter the wrestling room at this time.
9. It is recommended that all wrestling gear (shoes, knee pads, headgear, bag) be disinfected after every practice.

***ALL MATS AND EQUIPMENT WILL BE SANITIZED BEFORE AND AFTER EACH PRACTICE**
