Revere's Scott Dressler Named Ohio's School Resource Officer of the Year

(June 16, 2020) – Officer Scott Dressler has been named Ohio's School Resource Officer of the Year for 2020. The award is given out annually by the Ohio School Resource Officers Association (OSROA) to one deserving SRO in the state.

The winning candidate must have been an SRO in a school district for at least two years and show an outstanding commitment to the community they serve.

Officer Dressler just completed his third year as SRO with Revere Local. Officer Dressler has been instrumental in running safety drills, organizing Stop the Bleed training, and implementing the installation of vaping detectors to combat this health epidemic facing our youth. Most recently during the pandemic, Officer Dressler helped to organize a food pantry at the Richfield Police Department for local families in need.

"We are beyond proud of Officer Dressler, who is more than deserving of this award for all of the hard work he provides to our district on a daily basis," said Dr. Matthew Montgomery, Revere Local Superintendent. "He knows our students and their families, and he works tirelessly to help provide support whenever and wherever he is needed."
