

Report Card Release: October 14, 2021




For the second year, schools and districts will not receive grades or ratings.

The Revere staff, students, and families can be extremely proud of our academic achievements. We want and should celebrate our remarkable educators and students!



To highlight a few examples, 94.0% of our fourth grade ELA scored at or above proficient which is the top ranking for Summit County. Revere fourth grade Math scores also ranked high, with 90.3% of students at or above proficiency.



88.4 percent of seventh grade ELA scored at or proficient and seventh grade Math also scored well with 75.8 percent proficient or higher.



At the high school level, our students are ranked at the top in English-Language Arts (ELA2) and Algebra, with 89.7% and 89.3% of students, respectively, scoring at or above proficient.



These achievement scores are just a few “snapshots” of data we can celebrate. Our school improvement model will provide our staff with the tools to analyze these data, find other areas for celebration, and highlight opportunities for improvement. All schools are creating growth plans with goals aligned to the newly approved Strategic Plan and Vision of a Minuteman. Clearly, there is much to be celebrated.
