Ability to pay this fee has been in your account since the fall. If you are unsure if you owe money, check your account to see if you already paid this fee. #### **Additional prom information**

- Prom ticket sales are April 24 – 27. Tickets are required and must be purchased in advance. No ticket sales at the door. Purchase your prom ticket in your PaySchools Central account by Thursday, April 27. Deadline for pre-sale price is 3:00 pm.
- Guests must be in high school or 1 year removed from high school graduation; must have the prom guest form filled out by their school administrator if a non-RHS student.
- Tickets purchased April 28<sup>th</sup> through May 3<sup>rd</sup> at 3:00 p.m. will incur an additional charge of \$25 per ticket.
- NO tickets may be purchased after May 3<sup>rd</sup> at 3:00p.m.
- No refunds will be issued. (Emergency situations will be considered by administration.)
- Prom contracts are required for all participants. Even after you purchase tickets online, you must submit your completed prom contract by April 27<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 pm. These forms must be submitted to Mrs. Repp before you may select your table assignments and prior to admittance to prom.
- **Prom Table Sign-Up May 3<sup>rd</sup> at 2:37 pm in room A210** (Mrs. Repp): Seating will be first come first serve. 10 students per table. You must submit payment and a signed prom contract in order to sign-up for a table. No exceptions will be made. No tables or seats will be held without signed prom contracts and payment. Students are encouraged to arrange groups prior to signing up. No individuals will be permitted to adjust or reassign tables once paperwork and payment has been received.
- **Prom Dress Code:** Basic concepts of the school dress code policy will be enforced. Please keep this in mind when renting or purchasing your attire. Please choose wisely and check with the senior advisor (Mrs. Repp) prior to the dance if you are in doubt.
