

REVERE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION MEETING MINUTES April 10, 2018

Secretary's Report:

- The minutes from the February 20, 2018 meeting were reviewed (online: www.revereschools.org/Page/2363) prior to the meeting and approved without correction.

Treasurer's Report:

- \$4631.46 Checking (includes a returned check from the US Treasury)
- \$2744.97 Savings

President's Report:

OLD COSTS—E-mail Requests:

- 1/27/18: Following were approved via e-mail vote on 1/27/18 to expedite the payment process.
 1. \$400 to the United States Treasury for FORM 1023 (Application for recognition of exemption).
 2. \$40 to Revere Local Schools for reimbursement in regards to purchases for the RHS Athletic HOF Social (RAA had previously voted and agreed to cover those costs for the social).
- 3/12/18: Following were approved via e-mail vote on 3/12/18 to expedite the payment process.
 1. Up to \$600 for graduate yard signs (cost split with Revere Education Association). RAA and REA voted on the design of the sign.

New Requests:

1. The \$400 check to the US Treasury was returned and VOIDED. We were given the wrong amount to pay, correct amount should have been around \$600. Asking for up to \$750 for tax filing to the United States Treasury for FORM 1023 (Application for recognition of exemption) the additional amount would cover any additional fees incurred. Weidrick, Livesay, & Company is correcting the paperwork and will get back to us.
2. \$664.20 to Wedirick, Livesay, & Company for tax filing (original invoice was \$2,408 a discount was applied to bring the invoice down to \$664.20). NOTE: No cost of service was discussed prior to work being done.
3. Up to \$1,600 for graduate yard signs. Cost of 500, signs 2-3 years' worth at 5.50 a sign, is \$2,750 plus freight. Splitting cost with REA to bring ours to \$1,600 or under.
4. \$20 to Crown Trophy of Medina for plaque.

The 4 new requests were put to a vote and all 4 requests passed.

Agenda:

- **Revere Hall of Fame:** The Induction is Tuesday May 22—May assembly for RHS students/staff (morning), followed by a luncheon sponsored by Revere Schools Foundation. Inductees will speak. Active Revere Alumni Association members will be invited to the assembly and luncheon along with past inductees. We would like to recognize Edna Larson at this event and present her plaque if she is available to attend.
- **Networking and Supporting Revere Business Owners:** At the February meeting we voted to move forward with this project. Dawn Divis will be the point person to create a Facebook page and begin networking. Phil and Dawn will work in collaboration on this project. Next newsletter will mention this project.  2. Identify and Promote Local Revere Graduate Professionals
